#### South Africa: Investing in slum communities

The centre serves around 100 children in the community. They have a drop-in centre where they take care of around 200 affected and/or affected children daily. Issued desks and chairs, new clothing, books and toys, have all helped them provide for the OVC under their care.

### Supporting vulnerable youth and women

South Sudan is the world's newest nation. Having just 11 years ago it has a massive task ahead for the country, though, with the impact of the outbreak of civil war. South Sudaners need a lot of support to build a better future. The new fact is that South Sudan has displaced around 2 million people, and a further 1 million live in the refugee camps.

And so what can we do for them? Our partner in South Sudan are working hard to improve local youth and women to learn sustainable skills, as well as providing community health and health education. Our team sent a huge shipment of goods including computers, appliances, furniture, and educational goods.

**Our teachers were sharing one big classroom with the level 3 students, or simply sitting outside the classroom to prepare lesson plans. The furniture has enabled us to provide enough tables and chairs and cupboards for all teachers, to add one staff room for the school's 1,400 students.**

Goods from Crossroads made a huge impact on their community, including:

- Speakers and microphones have enabled 4 schools to have sound systems for outdoor learning about activities and events.
- Desktop computers, enabled the setting up of a computer centre at school, and teachers can now learn how to use a laptop and present more effectively.
- 800 gift stickers on top of 400 hygiene soap bars were distributed to about 1000 people, helping them to learn about the importance of hand hygiene and the quality of the products they use.
- Community health centres for 40 patients. The health centre provides care for the local population and receive an average of 100 visits per day.
- The furniture enabled staff to provide enough tables and chairs and cupboards for all teachers in their school. They also furnished both the visitors and teacher's quarters where parents and future learning teachers can stop.
- Refrigerators were distributed to students, health centres and women washing centres to prevent food from going to waste more easily.
- The community radio station will improve programmes and services thanks to desktop computers and microphones from the shipment. This important communication service reaches audiences within a 100km range. 15 hours per day in 3 languages (English, Arabic, Afrikaans).

### Job training and education

Zambia has over a decade of economic growth in recent decades, but that nation has not yet reached the vision of a free market. There, the quality of life is still very low. The country has a lot of challenges, including a lot of unemployment (28% of the population).

Our NGO partners in Zambia have recognized the challenges that their communities face and for the last 10 years they have been working tirelessly to fix them.

They have established educational programmes across the country, teaching children from one school to another. They have also provided awareness projects, working to prevent human trafficking and to help the victims of HIV/AIDS, and they have funded a prison conversion project, helping to improve the lives and welfare of prisoners to provide them with new opportunities.

**"As a result of the shipment, we were able to meet the needs of over 2,000 vulnerable people from two different provinces. You have warmed the hearts of orphans, hurting children, and the aged vulnerable people of Zambia."** - NGO lead

Crossroads sent a shipment with strategically selected goods to help equip and expand their projects. They had all the most of the goods:

- School furniture and equipment has enabled them to open three new classrooms. The first had all the quality of the school furniture and multiple teachers and support staff included! They will add.
- Household goods and office furniture for their administrative offices and schools, plus they have saved more than USD2,000 from their budget.
- Medical equipment has helped supporting the delivery at their schools.
- During from the shipment has been a significant help to equip community members who can't afford basic necessities.
- More than 1,000 people have benefited through the goods donated.

We are highly grateful for all who made this shipment possible! This capital investment of goods will continue to benefit education and helping to build Zambia for a better future to come.

# Donation for Organization Development and Project Administration

## Support Us

EWB-HK aims at bridging pro bono engineers with beneficiaries on both organizational and individual bases. We value the professional uniqueness of our missions in Hong Kong as well as the collective and expanding intentions of our volunteers.

Apart from engineers, we also need volunteers from various professions or with diversified experiences to support the operation of and to develop EWB-HK. To be more specific, we need volunteers to take up project leader and coordinator roles as well as to provide technical backup, administrative support and relevant training to our volunteers. So if you are interested in joining us, please do so now.

Although EWB-HK is managed and operated by volunteers, funding is still one of the challenges we are facing. The income from membership fees is meant to pay off administrative costs only, which include employees, insurances, utilities, office and venue rentals, website construction and maintenance, etc.

The level of Membership fees collected fell far short of expenses even when we have no dedicated office and only one part-time employee. Since the current mode of operation burdens a few of the key roles in the organization, we need to break the bottlenecks by employing some staff members. In addition, to look for a set of premises to serve as an office and a place for volunteers to gather is also on the agenda. All these need money. Meanwhile, our projects in Hong Kong and overseas are currently operated on self-financed basis. However, we also welcome projects in some scale that will substantially improve the living of our target beneficiaries. Such projects, when they come by, may need capital costs.
