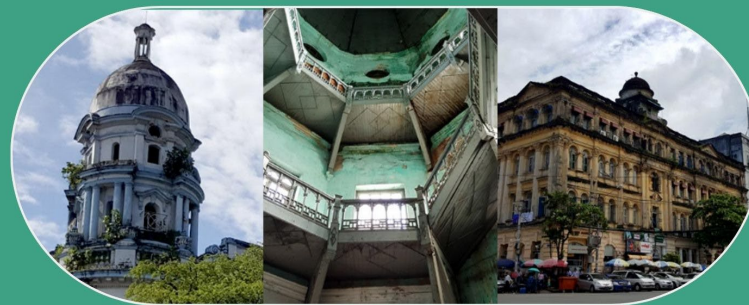

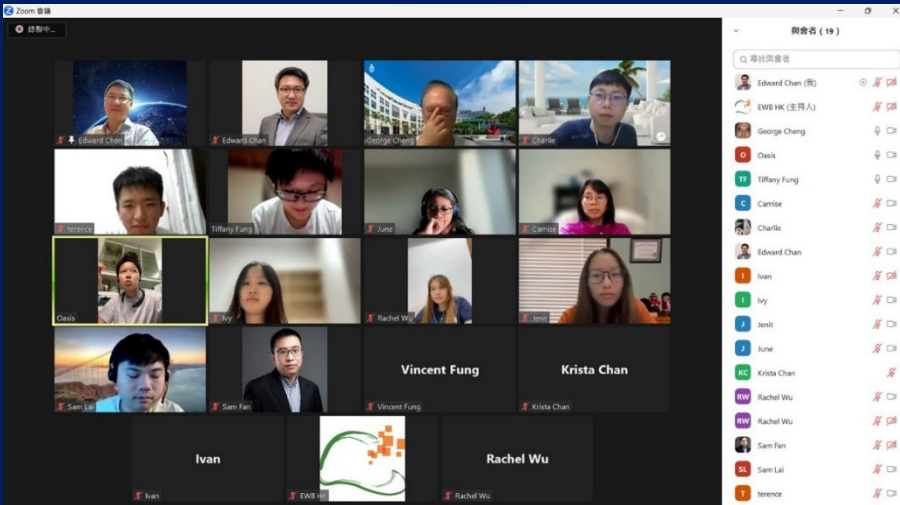

Message from the President of WFEO Prof. José Vieira

It has been 16 months since the launch of WFEO Academy, and I am proud to see how fast this important initiative has developed. The Academy has been designed as a training portal open to all engineers who are affiliated with one of the member institutions of WFEO, providing opportunities, at no cost, to develop their skills in fields that are the most relevant to adapt to the pressing challenges of sustainable development. We aim to mobilize engineers to deliver the right practice in the age of climate change.

There are now more than 30 courses available on the portal, with a scope that encompasses training for engineering educators, for accreditation bodies to achieve international standards and professional skills development. This rapid increase in available courses is largely due to the major contribution of our members and partners. I want to express my gratitude towards them.

WFEO, through its Committee on Education in Engineering (CEIE), will continue to develop the number and the scope of the Academy training material.

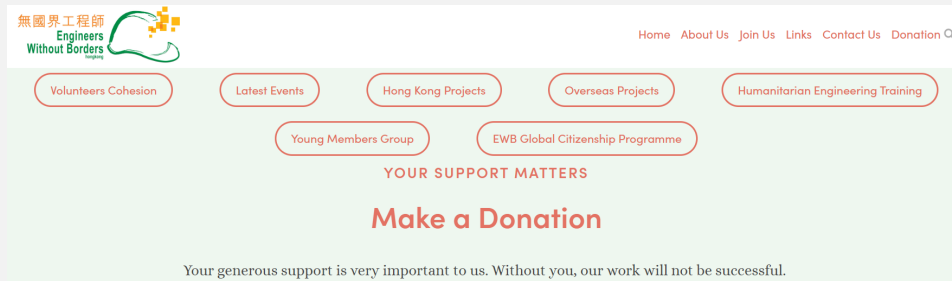
The level of Membership fees collected fell far short of expenses even when we have no dedicated office and only one part-time employee. Since the current mode of operation burdens a few of the key roles in the organization, we need to break the bottlenecks by employing some staff members. In addition, to look for a set of premises to serve as an office and a place for volunteers to gather is also on the agenda. All these need money. Meanwhile, our projects in Hong Kong and overseas are currently operated on self-financed basis. However, we also welcome projects in some scale that will substantially improve the living of our target beneficiaries. Such projects, when they come by, may need capital costs.
