15 Years of EWB Hong Kong

15 years ago, 2008... The inception of establishing EWB Hong Kong came from the earthquake disaster in SiChuan, China, 12 May 2008. The disaster had taken over 69,000 lives in the towns and rural areas. After that, there were substantial reforms in school and building construction safety codes and standards. Today, the structural design requirements for buildings in the Mainland and HK are much more stringent than before, in turn, safer.



Apart from natural disasters, climate risk is alarming us nowadays. Climate resilience is one of the concerns across seven continents, the extreme weather has threatened the survival of human beings.

The formation of **Urban Sustainability team** in EWB HK is echoing the various sustainability issues across climate, health, environment, work, economy, and the essence of partnership.

EWB Asia Network has been set up to accelerate and deepen the partnership across EWB peers in Asia and counterparts of other continents.

History of the Global Citizenship Program

EWB-HK launched the EWB Global Citizenship Program in 2018 to respond to the needs of young generations to tackle the challenges faced in the rapid-changing world.

The program is designed to prepare students at tertiary education level and young engineers to become a global citizen with knowledge of real world sustainability issues, and hence create sustainable engineering solutions to contribute with their technical expertise in their future career whilst to offer technical supports to the disadvantaged communities.

GCP 2023

The EWB-HK Global Citizenship Program 2023 had 18 participants as we expanded our recruitment to 8 Universities. Along with our partners ImpactHK, Crossroads Foundation, and Bamboo Generations, we added local partner Drink Without Waste. This year we expanded the support of corporations with Swire Coca Cola HK offering to organize Workshop and service activity in Tin Shui Wai focusing on Beverage Container Waste and Sygna providing support for our International Service Trip and the EWB Asia Conference on Climate Change. MAKE Studios offered a committed resource to help plan and deliver a focused curriculum to achieve an IMPACT.

Progress of EWB Asia network:
